## **Outfitter/Hunter Contract Over the Counter Hunt**

**All hunts are subject to NM State Gross receipts tax. 5.25-8.4375%**

Instructions for completing forms: Print out contract and waiver. On contract check the line next to hunt you would like to book. Complete in legible hand writing, sign and make copies for yourself of contract and waiver forms and mail originals with deposit to the address above. Please contact me to check on hunt dates and availability prior to filling out contract!

All Barbary sheep, Mountain Lion, and Bear hunts include meals and lodging, transportation during your hunt, field care of your animal, and a guide for the number of days specified on hunt. Hunters are responsible for their own transportation to and from camp location, state license, habitat stamps, big game tag, taxidermy, meat processing, shipping of game, and New Mexico gross receipts tax. There is a 50% deposit due immediately upon booking a hunt and the remainder of the hunt cost is due 30 days prior to arrival in camp. No checks will be accepted upon arrival to camp. No exceptions!

Deposits are nonrefundable! If for any reason you have to cancel your hunt, deposits may be transferred to a future hunt. Any cancellations less than 60 days prior to your hunt may be subject to forfeiture.

Hunters are responsible for purchasing their hunting license, habitat stamps, and big game tags through the New Mexico Game and Fish. All over the counter tags must be purchased 14 days prior to you coming on your hunt or you will not have your licenses in time.

Hunter understands and agrees that Antler Mountain Outfitters enforces a wounded animal policy. If a hunter wounds an animal ultimately determined by the (guide), they must work to retrieve that animal for a minimum of 24 hours. Antler Mountain Outfitters reserves the right to end any hunt due to a hunter mortally wounding an animal. This will be at the sole discretion of the guide/outfitter. We strive to retrieve any and all animals shot to the best of our ability.

## **Waiver and Release Agreement**

I understand that these risks, hazards and dangers include without limitation: 1) Activities involving mules and horses in rugged country; 2) Encounters with wildlife, animals and insect; 3) Activities involving wilderness travel and camping; 4) Inclement weather conditions; 5) ATV's and other vehicles; and 6) Activities involving bows/arrows and firearms. I understand the risks, hazards and dangers described above and have had the opportunity to discuss them with Antler Mountain Outfitters LLC. I understand these activities may require good physical conditioning and a moderate degree of outdoor skills and knowledge. I believe I have good physical conditioning and the degree of outdoor skills and knowledge for me to safely engage in these activities. I understand that I have responsibilities. I am voluntarily using the services of Antler Mountain Outfitters LLC with full knowledge of the inherent risks, hazards and dangers of the activities described above and have discussed them with Antler Mountain Outfitters LLC. I hereby assume and accept any and all risks of injury, paralysis or death. Lastly, I, for myself, my heirs, successors, executors, and subrogees, hereby knowingly and intentionally waive and release, indemnify and hold harmless Antler Mountain Outfitters LLC, their directors, officers, agents, employees, and volunteers from and against any and all claims, actions causes of action, liabilities, suits expenses (including reasonable attorney's fees) which are related to, arise out of, or are in any way connected with my participation in these activities.
